



## Guilford County Schools

### **Home/Hospital Services**

Any Guilford County Schools student may be eligible for instruction in the home if he/she is medically or physically unable to attend school for four weeks or longer as documented by a physician.

Home/Hospital placement shall be temporary with a goal of returning the student to a less restrictive environment within the school year unless there is medical information which would require extended home/hospital instruction.

The Home/Hospital Program is not a long-term alternative to regular school attendance. Rather, it is a short-term service that provides instructional services so that the student can return to school with the knowledge and skills sufficient to maintain his/her previous level of academic performance. All students who are disabled to the extent that they are unable to attend school may receive instruction from a Home/Hospital teacher at local hospitals, their homes or at predetermined community locations.
